The Mobile Response Team (MRT) will provide immediate, on-site behavioral health crisis intervention services to individuals of all ages in Miami-Dade County. MCRTs will:



Licensed Behavioral Health Personnel will respond on-site within 60 minutes



Specialized personnel triage calls

IF SOMEONE:

- Is experiencing a mental health or emotional crisis; or
- Is experiencing escalating emotional or behavioral health reactions and symptoms that impact their ability to function typically within the family, living situation, or community environment; or,
- Is served by the child welfare system and/or are experiencing or at high risk of placement instability.

OUR GOAL: Lessen the trauma, divert from emergency departments, and prevent unnecessary psychiatric hospitalizations.

MOBILE RESPONSE SERVICES ENCOMPASS AN ARRAY OF CRISIS INTERVENTIONS, INCLUDING:

- Evaluation and assessment
- Development of safety or crisis plans
- Providing or facilitating stabilization services
- · Supportive crisis counseling
- Education
- Development of coping skills
- Referral and linkage to appropriate resources including connecting individuals to ongoing mental health and substance use services
